If you applied for a technical position, please be prepared to answer technical questions to exhibit your proficiency in coding, algorithms and data structures.

Ask Questions

This may be the single most crucial tip for your success. It tells us how interested and passionate you are about the position, you'll learn more about what it is really like working here, and it will help create rapport, so the interview becomes a natural two-way conversation.
